

Quick FAQ: Costa del Sol Trains

Q: Can I pay with contactless cards or phone?

A: Yes. You can tap-and-go directly at the green turnstile gates using your smartphone, smartwatch, or credit card. Always tap out at your destination!

Q: Are electric scooters allowed on board?

A: No. Electric scooters (patinetes eléctricos) are strictly banned on all Spanish trains. Standard bicycles are 100% free and allowed.

Q: Is there a weight limit for luggage?

A: No. There are no formal luggage restrictions or weight limits on the local C1 commuter trains, and carriages have open areas for large bags.

Quick FAQ: Costa del Sol Trains

Q: Can I travel with my dog?

A: Yes. Small pets travel for free. Dogs must be kept on a lead and wear a muzzle, or travel inside a secure pet carrier.

Q: Are the train stations wheelchair accessible?

A: Yes. The vast majority of the C1 line—including the Airport and Fuengirola—is fully accessible with lifts and step-free platforms.
